Minutes of the July 7, 2008 VADA-CH Meeting

VADA CH Board Meeting July 8th, 2008

The VADA CH board meeting was held Tuesday July 8th at Vinny's Restaurant on 29 North. The meeting was called to order by our chapter president, Melyni Worth. Those in attendance were Catherine Kern, Kim Schmidt, Carter Bass, Jan Templeton, Nancy Lowey, Tina Longaker, Amy Gadsden, Calla Belle, Gardy Bloemers, Michael Marino, Sandra Aldrich, Lauren Forestell, Beth Marcindo, Sherri Booye, Melyni Worth, Martha Mellish, Odette Wilkins, Steve Widner, Mary Lou Watt.

Sherri Booye reported VADA CH currently has ninety six members with \$7,698.87 in the treasury account.

The scholarship drawing was held resulting in Hollyn Mangione and Sandra Aldrich being our chapter's winners for the lower level scholarship. This includes training level through 4th. Carter Bass was the winner of the scholarship award for the upper levels. Three Hundred Dollars will be given to each winner by VADA CH to be used toward furthering their dressage education.

Tina Longaker gave an update regarding the upcoming Team Competitions to be held the first weekend in August. A unanimous vote by the board supported Melyni Worth's suggestion of VADA CH providing volunteer t-shirts. Nancy Lowey reported that volunteers are still needed and to please contact her if anyone is willing to help.

A discussion of the September Twin Shows was held. The September 13th show day will be coordinated by the Frederickburg Dressage Chapter. VADA CH will coordinate the show day of September 14th. Gardy Bloemers reported that she is working on recruiting sponsorships and class prizes. If interested in sponsorship, please contact Gardy. \$50.00 will sponsor a high score class, \$35.00 will sponsor a regular class. Gardy Bloemers introduced Beth Marcinko to the chapter. Beth will be the volunteer coordinator of The Twin Shows. Please contact Beth if you are interested in volunteering. It was decided by the board that again a used tack sale will be offered at the show. VADA CH however will take full responsibility of the tack sale. Sandra Aldrich, Hollyn Mangioni, and Mary Lou Watt volunteered to assist with the sale.

Sherri Booye reminded everyone that the chapter's August "Evening With" is scheduled to be held August 5th at Sherri's house. Dr. Mellish and Dr. Worth will together conduct a seminar on laminitis. Dinner will be provided, compliments of Sherri Booye.

Tina Longaker gave a report on the most recent VADA State meeting. She reported that VADA currently has \$75,000 in their treasury. \$1000 of this money is slated to go to the USDF Region One and to the Young/Junior Riders team travelling to Colorado for the 2008 NAJYRC. In 2009 VADA is scheduled to offer a clinic with Anne Gribbons. Tina mentioned the possibility of VADA subsidizing this clinic.

VADA will be hosting the BLM in 2008. The GAIG qualifying classes offered at our show will be for 2009 and the BLM qualifying will be for 2008. This is a change from the prizelist published in the USDF Region 1 Omnibus.

A discussion of VADA's Purple Book was initiated by Sherri Booye. She reported that the creation of the "Purple Book" is becoming costly. A discussion was held suggesting the possibility of offering advertising for a fee in the book or perhaps members paying partially or in full for the "Purple Book". No official vote was taken, but in a general discussion it was agreed upon that the "Purple Book" is a valuable tool and reference source for all VADA members.

A closing business report was given by Nancy Lowey regarding the possibility of signing a contract with Commonwealth Park for 2009. Nancy and Sherri Booye testified to the recent building improvements at Commonwealth. Both reported good footing, nice warm up area, building updates, and easy access.

Melyni Worth adjourned the meeting after no further discussion.

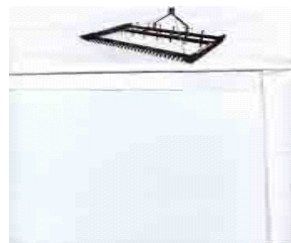

* **FREESTYLES:** Freestyle rider must present a good quality tape to the Secretary by **10 AM the day of the class.** The sound system will be available for testing, to be announced at show.

*Rings may be watered periodically should the weather conditions warrant.

TIMES: Please **DO NOT** include post card or envelope with entry. Times will be posted on the VADA-CH Website.

STABLING: \$35.00 Saturday night through Sunday. **NO Initial bedding.** Permanent Stalls with small half doors, stallions may need additional stall guards for doors. **PLEASE note on your entry if you are entering the Fredericksburg show on Saturday, September 13, 2008.**

ARENAS: 2 outdoor sand/blue stone arenas, 20m X 60m. Grass and sand/bluestone warm-up. Grass area for lungeing.

FOOD: Available on grounds
