Minutes of the June 17, 2008 VADA-CH Meeting

Attendees: Melyni Worth, Tina Longaker, Martha Mellish, Sandra Aldrich, and Sherri Booye. Mary Lou Watt could not attend, but gave her proxy to Tina so that we could have a quorum.

The treasury balance is \$7,805.50.

The chapter currently has 90 paid members.

Moving the August meeting to the first Tuesday was discussed in order for Melyni to be present and participate in the Evening With discussion about laminitis. The group agreed to move the pool party and Evening With meeting from Saturday the 16th to the Tuesday evening meeting. The meeting will start

an hour earlier at 6:00 pm and pizza and a veggie platter and drinks will be provided. It will be held at Sherri Booye's place in Troy. A notice will be drafted and placed in the July and August newsletters and on the web site.

The visit to Commonwealth Park was the next item on the agenda. Melyni, Tina, and Sherri will meet with the Fredericksburg chapter representatives and the Commonwealth staff and tour the facility to determine if we want to move the licensed shows to this facility. Will report back next month on the visit.

Noted that the newsletter should put in a notice that anyone that has applied for the scholarship awards drawing must be present at the July meeting at Vinny's in order to win. This will also be posted on the web site.

The Adult Team competition at Commonwealth Park is coming up soon and volunteers are needed.

A general discussion of the proposed USDF qualifications standards revealed that we were all opposed to the standards but that it was likely to pass since a cadre of upper echelon riders want it.

We discussed Lori Allhouse's membership problem and agreed it was just a mistake and agreed to allow her shores to count for the year end awards.

Noted that we need to form a committee this summer to recruit people to run for Chapter officer and Board positions for next year.

The VADA state board meeting is the Sunday after today's meeting and so there was no news to report from the State.

The meeting was then adjourned.

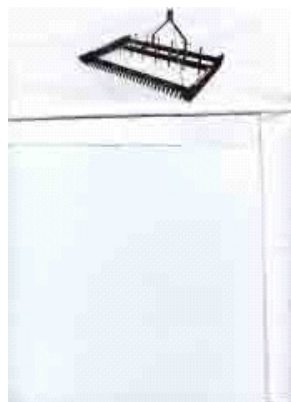

Matt McLaughlin studied primarily under Chuck Grant, USDF Hall of Fame member and recognized father of American Dressage. As a working student he not only furthered his dressage riding skills, but also learned the art of training horses in haute école for exhibition riding/performance. Matt spent the next seven years as the Principal Rider, Head Rider, and eventually Head Trainer for the Royal Lipizzaner Stallion Show where he trained as many as 16 stallions and riders for the daily performances all over North America, Europe, and Australia as well as performing his own high-energy solo acts. He has successfully trained horses through Grand Prix which have gone on to compete nationally and internationally as well as multiple horses finished in haute école including Capriole, Courbette and Levade. His dedication to the training of horse and rider is based on his system of horsemanship that integrates classical principles of dressage and Natural Horsemanship techniques with a focus on controllability of the mount.

Matt is currently training and showing horses for competitive dressage and in 2006 was awarded the USDF Bronze and Silver medals. Although he teaches and trains all levels, his passion is training piaffe, passage and haute école. This clinic will focus on working horses in hand and under saddle for piaffe and Spanish walk.

Dr. Martha Mellish:- is a 2005 graduate from the Atlantic Veterinary College, located in Prince Edward Island, Canada. After completing an equine internship at Woodside Equine Clinic, in Richmond, Virginia, she joined an equine only practice in the Shenandoah Valley. She has now joined Keswick Equine Clinic. As a dressage rider, she is very interested in the veterinary perspective of performance horse issues.

AWARDS: Trophy and six ribbons in each class. High percentage awards (MFS scores to be excluded): Overall, JR Overall, Overall Twin Shows High Score. All Young Horse tests are EXCLUDED from the High Score Awards. Additional High Score awards may be presented. Management reserves the right to split/combine classes if entries warrant. Ribbons and awards not picked up at show will not be mailed.

USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal: Awarded from class 11, Second Level Test 3

ENTRIES: Entries accepted by the date received by the secretary. You MUST use the 2008 Entry blank! Telephone entries will not be accepted.

All entries (competing & non-competing) MUST include a valid negative Coggins test (through 9/14/08) **or the entry WILL BE RETURNED.**

* An acknowledgment of entry SHOWING STATUS will be emailed or mailed to each competitor upon receipt of entry. Please check this for any errors. If you have any problems or do not receive this confirmation, please contact the Secretary immediately.

* Competitors are reminded that USEF rules require entry forms to be signed completely in all three signature blocks (no photocopies!). JR/YR riders are reminded to include their birth date or their entries will be returned; **Junior riders CANNOT sign as Rider or Trainer. Please have your parent or guardian sign. You MUST include an emergency contact and phone # (see stabling).**

*All riders must wear appropriate headgear when mounted.

* **FREESTYLES:** Freestyle rider must present a good quality tape to the Secretary by **10 AM the day of the class.** The sound system will be available for testing, to be announced at show.

*Rings may be watered periodically should the weather conditions warrant.

TIMES: Please **DO NOT** include post card or envelope with entry. Times will be posted on the VADA-CH Website.

STABLING: \$35.00 Saturday night through Sunday. **NO Initial bedding.** Permanent Stalls with small half doors, stallions may need additional stall guards for doors. **PLEASE note on your entry if you are entering the Fredericksburg show on Saturday, September 13, 2008.**

ARENAS: 2 outdoor sand/blue stone arenas, 20m X 60m. Grass and sand/bluestone warm-up. Grass area for lungeing.

FOOD: Available on grounds

MEDICAL WASTE:

All medical waste (needles, syringes, etc.) must NOT be discarded in stalls, manure pits, garbage cans or on grounds. All medical supplies must be placed in appropriate containers located in each barn.

DIRECTIONS: directions from I-95: take the Massaponax exit 126, Rt 1/Rt. 17 South. At the third traffic light, turn right onto Southpoint Pkwy. At Rt 208, Courthouse Rd, turn left. Go through 6 traffic lights and start looking for Rose Mount on the left. Horse show entrance is the **SECOND** Rose Mount farm entrance (marked). **From I-64:**

Go to exit 143 (Louisa, Rt 208). Go into Louisa, take right to stay on 208/522.; After a few miles, turn left on Rt 623, cross railroad tracks immediately after the turn; Stay on Rt 623 until it ends, then turn left on Rt 522/208.

Go 1/2 mile, then turn right on Rt 208 (again). Go to the end of the road, about 14 miles, you will be in Post Oak.

Turn right and go about 4 miles and make a hard left turn at the light to stay on Rt 208. Stay on Rt 208 into town of Spotsylvania and turn right on Courthouse Rd. at light (Spotsylvania Courthouse is on the corner). Go about 1 1/2 -2 miles, the farm is on your right with the stable entrance first.
